	<p>The REMAP curriculum is designed so that students learn what the SGS learning characteristics are, why they are important and what they need to do to develop in each of them.</p>	<p>The characteristics that we are aiming for the students to develop are grit, growth mindset, self-control, understanding others, gratitude, curiosity and zest. We refer to these as the SGS Learning Characteristics.</p>	<p>After an introductory course in the learning characteristics students continue their learning in context. They cover courses on Completing Challenges, Running a Young Enterprise, Helping others with Literacy, Equalities and Diversity, Developing Resilience and Maintaining Well-Being</p>	<p>Through the course of the year students complete a 'Reflection Log' where they record all the activities they have done in and out of school that have them developed in their learning characteristics. They also target their learning development on their 'WOOP' document. Teachers use these documents alongside the school reports to assess students' learning characteristics and mentor them to improve.</p>
