

REMOTE ACCESS FROM AN ANDROID DEVICE v003 03/10/14

Tested using Android version 4.2.2

1. Download & install the free App called "Microsoft Remote Desktop" version 8.0.11 from the App Store, using the following URL.
https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.microsoft.rdc.android&hl=en_GB
2. Once the "Microsoft Remote Desktop" App is installed.
3. Run the "**Microsoft Remote Desktop**" App.
4. Select – Gateways, Select - +
5. Gateway Name: **rds.sgs.uk.net**
6. Server: **rds.sgs.uk.net**
7. No need to Add User Name & Password here.
8. Select – Done.
9. Select – Remote Desktops, Select - +.
10. Connection Name: **SGS Remote Access**
11. PC Name: **rds.internal.steyning.w-sussex.sch.uk**
12. Gateway: Select – **rds.sgs.uk.net**, (this was created above in step 4)
13. No need to Add User Name & Password here, Select – Done.
14. Select - "**SGS Remote Access**".
15. In the User name field type your logon ID prefixed with sg e.g. **sg\12345**
16. In the password field type your school password.
17. Select – Logon
18. After the logon process has completed you will see your "Remote Access" Desktop as shown below.



19. After you have logged in click on "**SGS Remote Access**" at the top of the screen to get additional menu options.

Note: There are many Free Apps available supporting "Microsoft Remote Desktop" or (RDP), but these will not work with the Schools "Remote Access" unless they support "Microsoft Remote Desktop Server Gateway (RDS Gateway) 2008 R2.
