Other Uniform Guidance

Shoes

Shoes should be plain black and be able to raise a shine. For girls, heels should be of a safe and sensible height. Canvas shoes and trainers are **not** permitted.

Hairstyle:

Hair colours should be natural. Extreme styles of hair are unacceptable. If you are unsure, please contact the school in advance of the haircut or colour.

Jewellery:

Students may wear a watch and are permitted to wear a single stud in each ear. Other facial piercings must be removed or replaced with transparent studs. Under Health and Safety regulations, these must be removed for PE, technology and any other practical subjects.

Mobile phones:

Should not be seen or heard around the school. They may be used for educational purposes in lessons with the permission of the teacher. Music players should not be used in school.

Aerosols:

Aerosols include spray deodorant, perfume, body sprays and hairspray—these items will be confiscated and kept in the Medical Room where they can only be collected by parents/carers.
