

Sixth Form College Provisional Option Blocks for Year 12 2019-2020

Please choose one subject per block, with some blocks remaining empty; these will become your independent learning time. For most students this will be three subjects. You may add a GCSE re-sit as a fourth. If you are predicted at least 7 A's at GCSE or equivalent, then you may select four A levels. If you are opting for Further Maths or Core Maths which is AS only, you should also opt for four subjects in your study programme. EPQ and GCSE re-sits are coursed in addition to three A level or equivalent courses.
