

**Provisional Entry Requirements 2019/20** - The table below shows entry requirements as in the Steyning Grammar School Sixth Form College Prospectus. Where a student's estimated (or later, real) grade is borderline in the chosen subject, we will look at their interim forecast grades and seek Head of Faculty/Subject guidance. For overseas applicants without IGCSE or GCSE qualifications we will look at equivalent qualifications where English GCSE is specified in the entry criteria this can be in Language or Literature .

**The general minimum entry requirements for Steyning Grammar Sixth Form College is GCSE grades 9-4 in 5 subjects plus the requirements below for each individual subjects**

Course A Level/BTEC National	Entry Requirements
<b>BTEC level 3 Certificate in Applied Science</b>	Minimum 4-4 in Combined Science or 4 in two of the separate sciences. Minimum of 4 in English and Maths.
<b>Art</b>	Minimum grade 5 in Art and Design. Students without a GCSE in Art and Design would be considered via a portfolio and discussion with the Learning Leader of Art
<b>Biology</b>	Grade 6-5 in Combined Science, Grade 5 in Maths or Grade 6 in Biology + Grade 5 in another Science plus Grade 5 in Maths
<b>Business</b>	Minimum grade 4 in English and Maths
<b>BTEC level 3 /Certificate in Business</b>	Minimum grade 4 in English and Maths.
<b>Chemistry</b>	Grade 6-5 in Combined Science, Grade 6 in Maths (Grade 5 will be considered on an individual basis) or Grade 6 in GCSE Chemistry + Grade 5 in another Science plus Grade 6 in Maths
<b>Computer Science</b>	Grade 6 Maths and either a Grade 5 in Computer Science or practical experience of computer programming. A Grade 5 at Maths will be considered on an individual basis.
<b>Core Maths</b>	Grade 5 Maths.
<b>Dance</b>	Minimum Grade 5 in GCSE Dance or Level 2 Merit in BTEC Performing Arts (Dance. Grade 4 in English. Candidates with other external Dance qualifications will also be considered e.g. Grade 5 in Ballet.
<b>Design &amp; Technology: Product Design (3D)</b>	Grade 5 GCSE in either Resistant Materials, Engineering, Graphic or Electronic Products. Grade 4 in English and Maths.
<b>Drama &amp; Theatre Studies</b>	Grade 5 in Drama. Grade 5 in English. Practical Drama experience essential.
<b>Economics</b>	Grade 5 in English and Maths.
<b>English Language</b>	Grade 5 in English Language and English Literature.
<b>English Literature</b>	Grade 5 in English Language and English Literature.
<b>Environmental Science</b>	Grade 4 in Combined Science, or Grade 4 in Biology plus Grade 4 in Maths and English.
<b>Extended Project</b>	9-5 Grade passes in all GCSE courses and strong A level progress in Y12.
<b>Film Studies</b>	Grade 4 in English.
<b>French</b>	Grade 5 French.
<b>Further Maths</b>	Grade 7 in Maths
<b>Geography</b>	Grade 5 in Geography. Grade 4 in English and Maths.
<b>Politics</b>	Grade 4 in English. Grade 5 in a Humanities GCSE preferred.
<b>BTEC level 3 Certificate Health &amp; Social Care</b>	Grade 4 in English and Maths. Grade 4 in a Science is desirable. Health and Social Care at KS4 is not a requirement.
<b>History</b>	Grade 5 in History or Grade 5 in English.
<b>Mathematics</b>	Grade 6 in Maths.
<b>Media Studies</b>	Grade 4 in English.
<b>Music</b>	Grade 5 in Music, or Music Practitioner or BTEC level 2 Distinction, or considerable independent experience of music. If formal music has not been studied before then an audition will be needed to judge capacity for the course. Although formal exams do not have to have been taken students will need to be at a minimum of Grade 5 on their instrument.
<b>Music Practitioner</b>	Music GCSE grade 4 or Music Practitioner or BTEC level 2 Merit or above, or considerable independent experience of music. If formal music has not been studied before then a discussion will be needed to judge capacity for the course.
<b>Photography</b>	Grade 4 in Art or DT. Grade 4 in English. All students are required to provide an entry portfolio. Photography A level is part of the Art, Craft and Design Edexcel specification but you do not need to have an Art GCSE to be eligible.

<b>Physical Education</b>	Grade 4 in PE. Grade 4 in Science. Must perform in a Sport at club level or higher.
<b>Physics</b>	Grade 6-5 in Combined Science. Grade 6 in Maths or Grade 6 in GCSE Physics + Grade 5 in another GCSE Science plus Grade 6 in Maths.
<b>Psychology</b>	Grade 4 in Maths. Grade 5 in Science. Grade 5 in English.
<b>Religious Studies</b>	Grade 4 in English. Grade 5 in a Humanities subject.
<b>Sociology</b>	Grade 4 in English. Grade 5 in a Humanities subject.
<b>Spanish</b>	Grade 5 in Spanish.
<b>BTEC level 3 Diploma/Certificate in Sport</b>	Grade 4 in PE OR Grade 4 in Science. It is not possible to study BTEC Level 3 Sport and A level PE.
<b>GCSE Retake for Maths and English</b>	For an early retake a Grade 3 at the end of Year 11 is required.

**A BTEC Level 3 Diploma course equate to two A levels**
